



Possibility Scholarship Application

SUNY Oswego's **Possibility Scholars Program** supports high-achieving and financially needy students in the Oswego and Syracuse city school districts who are committed to study in the **science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM)** fields.

There are several benefits to students who receive this award including:

- **Need-based renewable scholarship-** Covers tuition, fees, room and board for up to four years at SUNY Oswego in coordination with other existing financial aid
- **Summer Research Institute-** Summer stipend, room and board; covers expenses to work with a faculty mentor matched to your research interest and career goals
- **International Experience-** Funding for an international learning experience to study real-world problems such as emerging diseases, climate change, poverty and sustainable energy

Eligibility Requirements:

To be considered for the Possibility Scholars program, all applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a resident of the Oswego City School District or Syracuse City School District.
2. Complete an application for admission to SUNY Oswego (via the SUNY or Common Application at www.oswego.edu/apply), and qualify for regular admission as a freshman for the fall term.
3. Obtain a Possibility Scholarship nomination from an educator at your school. This nomination should speak to your accomplishments in STEM subjects, including any special projects you've completed, and your potential to succeed in a STEM field in college.
4. Be admitted to a science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM) major.*
5. Demonstrate high potential for success in a STEM field.
6. Document high financial need as demonstrated by a financial aid application (FAFSA).
7. Preference given to first-generation college students.
8. Plan to live in a Residence Hall on the Oswego State Campus.
