

Subject: Faculty International Travel Grant Proposals

The Office of International Education and Programs is pleased to announce the Faculty International Travel Grants competition for 2011. These grants are intended to support full-time faculty who wish to travel outside the United States to present papers at conferences, to do research, to support the creation of new courses that will include education abroad opportunities for Oswego students, and to bring international themes further into the curriculum.

Funding this year is limited. All interested faculty should complete an application form which can be downloaded from our web site (<http://www.oswego.edu/intled>) in the "Faculty" section. Submit the application to my attention to the Office of International Education and Programs, 100 Sheldon Hall, by April 4, 2011 for the spring and summer round, and by Friday of the first week of classes for the fall round.

An experienced committee of faculty members composed of previous years' grant awardees will review and advise on the process for application, selection, and awards, and make recommendations to the Director of International Education and Programs. Due to funding limits, priority will be given to those faculty members who have not received an OIEP travel grant in the past three years. Recipients will be notified approximately four weeks after the deadline for submission. Upon completion of the travel, grantees must submit a brief written report of their activities. Future consideration for a travel grant will depend upon this report being submitted in a timely fashion after completion of the travel.
