

A-DWI

- Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated.
- Blood alcohol content (BAC) .18 and higher.
- First offense carries a minimum fine of \$1,000, a minimum one year license revocation and a jail sentence of up to one year.

DWI

- Driving While Intoxicated.
- BAC .08 or higher.
- First offense carries a minimum fine of \$500, a minimum six month license revocation and a jail sentence of up to one year.

DWAI

- Driving While Ability Impaired.
- BAC from .05 - .07.
- First offense carries a minimum fine of \$300, a 90 day license suspension and a jail sentence of up to 15 days.

Zero Tolerance

- Drivers under 21 with a BAC from .02 - .07.
- First offense carries a minimum fine of \$225 and a six month license suspension.

Did You Know...

...In 2008, an estimated 26 % of young adults age 21-25 drove under the influence.

...The rate of alcohol impairment among drivers in fatal crashes was four times higher at night than during the day (36 % vs. 9 %).

...One third of the fatalities in New York State involve impaired or intoxicated drivers or pedestrians.

DWI On Campus
