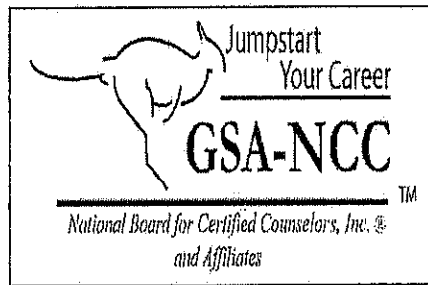

CPS APPLICATION Deadline:
June 24, 2005

The Counseling and Psychological Services Department will be participating in the Board Eligible Graduate Student Application process for the National Certified Counselor credential (GSA-NCC). This process is designed for students currently enrolled in degree programs requiring 48 semester hours. Students successfully completing this exam would have a head start on the National Certified Counselor (NCC) credentialing process, will have a lower NCC application fee, and have a convenient on-campus testing site.

This is a special administration of the National Counselor Examination (NCE). Only students currently enrolled in the CPS department programs of Counseling Services or Human Services/Community Counseling can participate. Please read carefully the following Eligibility Chart for the exam administration. HS/CC students and the MS degree students in CS fall in the Master's Student category (fee \$230). The Counseling Services CAS students are considered Ed.S. students (fee \$265). *Please note that this exam does not replace the department's comprehensive examination required for graduation (the CPCE).*

*Ed.S. students must complete a Board Eligible GSA-NCC application unless their Ed.S. program is CACREP-accredited.

Interested CPS students must apply prior to June 24, 2005. All application materials can be picked up in the CPS office, 321 Mahar Hall, and **MUST BE RETURNED** to the CPS office, not the NBCC office. A check for the exam fee must be submitted with the completed application packet. *A minimum of five students must sign up for the exam before SUNY Oswego can be designated as a test site. Your check will be returned if the minimum number of students is not met.*
