_____ E. John (age 19) is arrested for implanting a computer virus into the University system in which he is a student.

_____ F. Joseph (age 20) and Jacob (age 22) are caught with stolen property. The police suspect they are responsible for a string of burglaries that took place over the course of the summer.

_____ G. Michael (age 26) said it was Roberta's (age 24) fault that he punched her in the face during an argument. Roberta is 6 months pregnant.

_____ H. Russell (age 16) is picked up by the police for questioning in a drive-by shooting that appeared to be gang related.

_____ I. Luther (age 36) has been arrested for his role in operating a narcotics distribution network.

_____ J. Executives from a nuclear weapons facility are indicted for their individual role in the illegal disposal and storage of hazardous wastes.
