In this presentation, we will examine in depth some of the more common reasons why parents kill their children. Additionally, we will discuss the strongest general risk factors seen in parents who kill their children. We will review signs and systems that would alert Child and Protective Services workers to impending tragedy and discuss possible intervention strategies.

Dr. Paul Martin, Consultant/Trainer: Dr. Martin has been trained as a forensic psychiatrist. He received his medical degree from the University of Des Moines, served his residency at Case Western University and his fellowship in psychiatry at Syracuse University. He is certified in mediation and arbitration; has experience with vision casting and solving conflict in the work place environment. His background as a psychiatrist brings a qualified perspective to problem solving issues in the workplace.
