

Clarification of GPA calculation for students pursuing second undergraduate degrees

Second Undergraduate Degrees

An individual may pursue a second undergraduate degree in a new field to fulfill a different academic objective. A student may not concurrently pursue two undergraduate degrees at Oswego. An individual who seeks admission/readmission to earn a second undergraduate degree must

1. Meet with an academic advisor in the major to develop a program of study
2. Submit that program of study to the appropriate academic associate dean for approval before registering for coursework
3. Complete and pass a minimum of 30 hours of coursework at Oswego after admission/readmission
4. Complete a minimum of one-half of the major and/or concentration requirements at Oswego after admission/readmission.
