SUNY students pay tuition and fees at their home campuses; please consult your Office of International Programs for applicable fees. New York State Community College students, CUNY, and Non-SUNY students pay tuition and fees to SUNY Oswego. These are approximate costs for one semester of study.

**Program differential includes: on-site orientation, instruction, room and board, textbooks, and some excursions.

***Total indicated includes repatriation insurance. Students choosing full insurance will be billed the additional amount. Full insurance costs range from \$317.00 - \$475.50 depending upon their length of study.

**** All students applying for the TESOL program are required to have a telephone interview with a representative from Masaryk University's TESOL Cambridge Program. This interview can normally last more than an hour at the student's expense. Students are encouraged to research companies for the most inexpensive international calling plan and to do so allowing enough time to have the plan in place in advance of this interview. TESOL is offered in the spring semester only.
