\*The amount shown is for tuition only. All students will also be billed for applicable college fees. SUNY students pay tuition and fees at their home campuses; please consult your Office of International Programs for applicable fees. New York State Community College students, CUNY, and Non-SUNY students pay tuition and fees to SUNY Oswego. These are approximate costs for one semester of study.

\*\* The Program differential includes airport pick-up, orientation program, housing placement and assistance, reduced cost cultural activities and excursions, instruction, evaluation, comprehensive advising, and student services by our Paris director.

\*\*\* Total indicated includes repatriation insurance. Students choosing full insurance will be billed the additional amount. Full insurance costs range from \$317.00 - \$475.50 depending upon length of study.

\*\*\*\* Participants have the choice of finding their own housing, living with a host family, or living in a foyer. Independent housing costs vary depending upon lifestyle choices, but range between \$500 - \$1000+ per month (plus fees if you use a housing agency). Students choosing the independent housing option will pay their housing costs overseas or to an agency prior to departure. Housing costs vary depending upon housing selection, but range between \$2900 - \$4800 per semester (see housing information for specifics). No refunds are made if a student moves out of his/her housing. Students choosing program-arranged housing will pay their housing costs to the OIEP at SUNY-Oswego prior to departure.
