To finalize your application process, please complete and return the originals of the following forms. Please keep a set of photocopies with you.

PRE-ACCEPTANCE

- ___ 1. SUNY Oswego Academic Exchange Application
- ___ 2. Estimated Bill Form completed and signed
- ___ 3. A bank statement signed and stamped by the bank official
- ___ 4. A scholarship letter, if applicable
- ___ 5. Official transcript or grade sheet (copies not accepted)
- ___ 6. SUNY Oswego Walker Health History and Immunization form (filled out completely)
- ___ 7. English language documentation (where required)

If English is not your mother tongue, or language of academic instruction you must submit TOEFL or IELTS scores or similar documentation of appropriate English language competency.

For the fall semester: Minimum TOEFL 76iBT or IELTS 6.0 and registration into two English courses.

For the spring semester: Minimum TOEFL 80iBT or IELTS 6.5.

POST-ACCEPTANCE

- ___ 8. Room and Board Agreement (Residence Life and Housing materials)
 - Students may live off-campus, but such housing is limited in availability, especially immediately prior to each semester.
 - Apartments may rent from \$325 upwards and utilities [electricity, gas and water) may be extra
- ___ 9. Visit the SUNY Oswego website and select courses through myoswego
 - Undergraduate minimum academic course load: 12 credit hours
 - Graduate minimum academic course load: 9 credit hours
- ___ 10. Provide airline arrival information
 - Send your detailed itinerary for arrival ON CAMPUS on the SPECIFIED DATE
