** Participants on this program *must* purchase either Puerto Rican Health Insurance or SUNY Full Health Insurance unless they can prove to the OIEP that they have their own health insurance which covers them in Puerto Rico. The insurance costs are not included in the above total program cost.

*** Students are responsible for their own food. The University of Puerto Rico (UPR) does not have a meal plan. There is a kitchen on each floor of the residence hall and there are dining areas on campus and inexpensive restaurants near the campus.

**** There are two housing options at UPR, Plaza Universitaria and Torre del Norte. The Plaza costs \$220 per month, plus a housing deposit of \$220. Torre del Norte costs \$220 per semester.
