Full health coverage and accident insurance is required for all participants on a State University of New York overseas academic program. Students may continue coverage under their own policy, provided it will cover them while overseas, for the entire duration of their program. Students must provide proof of their existing coverage by supplying the SUNY Oswego Office of International Education and Programs with their policy plan, insurance carrier and policy number in the space provided.

If the student does not currently have health and accident insurance that will cover them while they are overseas, this coverage must be purchased through SUNY.
