Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day	Monday, January 21
Lincoln's Birthday ^{1,2}	Tuesday, February 12
Washington's Birthday	Monday, February 18
Memorial Day	Monday, May 26
Independence Day	Friday, July 4
Labor Day	Monday, September 1
Columbus Day	Monday, October 13
Election Day ³	Tuesday, November 4
Veteran's Day	Tuesday, November 11
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 27
Christmas Day	Thursday, December 25

¹Lincoln's Birthday is a "floating holiday" for M/C employees and employees represented by CSEA and PS&T. Employees in the Security Services and Security Supervisors negotiating units will observe Lincoln's Birthday as a fixed holiday.

²For employees represented by UUP who are eligible to observe holidays, Lincoln's Birthday is not a "floating holiday". The "floating holiday" for UUP employees is the day after Thanksgiving.

³Election Day will be considered a "floating holiday" unless notified differently.
