**Constructing the Worlds of Adirondack Postcard Photographers**

Distinguished Professor of Sociology and Cultural Foundations of Education, Robert Bogdan of Syracuse University has been Director of the Doctoral Program in Social Science at Syracuse University since 1994. Co-author of two longtime, standard textbooks on qualitative research, his most recent research has focused upon the postcard photographer of turn-of-the-century Adirondack mercantiles. In both *Exposing the Wilderness* (1999) and *Adirondack Vernacular* (2003), Bogdan presents a grounded inquiry into their world and their art, as seen through their lights and lenses.
