*Searching for job opportunities online can be a long.... and frustrating process if you don't know where to look. Below are our top picks for the best online job sites.*

**America's Job Bank** ([www.ajb.dni.us/](http://www.ajb.dni.us/)): The US Department of Labor has developed this site in collaboration with each state as well as private sector organizations. Search for positions by job title, keyword, zip code, and link to each state's "Employment Services" site.

**Regional Listing** (<http://www.oswego.edu/careerservices/joblinks/nysjobs.html>): The SUNY Oswego Career Services office has compiled a listing of regional resources including information on Central and Western NY, the Capital Region, NYC, Long Island, the Hudson and Mohawk Valleys and the Southern Tier.

**Monstertrak** ([monstertrak.com](http://monstertrak.com)): One of the first job sites, and still one of the best! Develop search engines to assist you in finding local, national and international positions. You can also search positions by your major and other interests.

**Best Jobs USA** ([BestjobsUSA.com](http://BestjobsUSA.com)): Search for positions by career category, geographic location or by keyword. There is a nice feature to allow you to search for very local positions.

**Popular Locations** (<http://www.oswego.edu/careerservices/joblinks/popularjobs.html>): The SUNY Oswego Career Services office has compiled a listing of job resources in the more popular locations such as California, Maryland, North Carolina, Washington, etc.

**Hotjobs.com** ([Hotjobs.com](http://Hotjobs.com)): Search for positions by career area, keyword, location, company, staffing firm, and more. Has international sites for Canada and Australia

**Local Positions** (<http://www.oswego.edu/careerservices/vacancies/vacancies.html>): Use our online search engine to find job opportunities sent to the SUNY Oswego Career Services office by local and regional employers. Search the database by career field, industry, city, or name of organization.

**Headhunter.net** ([headhunter.net](http://headhunter.net)): Mix and match up to thirteen criteria (keyword, location, salary, etc.) to find the right opportunities. You can also save searches, get email updates and search by industry or company.

**Career City** ([careercity.com](http://careercity.com)): a good search engine to assist you in finding employment in certain US cities, Canada and Mexico. Also keyword and industry searchable.

**SUNY CDO** (<http://www.sunycdo.org/>): The comprehensive web site for the SUNY Career Development Organization, an umbrella organization linking all the SUNY Career Services Offices. You can link to each Career Office, and search for their vacancies as well as access a list of career fairs throughout New York State! Organized by date; you'll want to verify admission protocol prior to attending. Some fairs are open only to that specific school's current students and alumni.
