Dr. Spitzer received the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Scholarship in 2003. He is the author of over 200 articles, essays, and papers appearing in many journals and books on a variety of American politics subjects. He formerly served as President of the Presidency Research Group of the American Political Science Association. He also served as a member of the New York State Commission on the Bicentennial of the U.S. Constitution, and has testified before Congress on several occasions, most recently before the U.S. Senate Judiciary Committee on the meaning of the Second Amendment's right to bear arms. Spitzer has appeared on NBC's *Today Show*, ABC's *Good Morning America* and *Network Nightly News*, PBS's *News Hour With Jim Lehrer*, CNN's *NewsStand*, *CNN & Co*" and *Insight*, CNBC's *Upfront Tonight*, NHK Television (Japan), the documentary film *Guns and Mothers* (aired on PBS on May 13, 2003).
