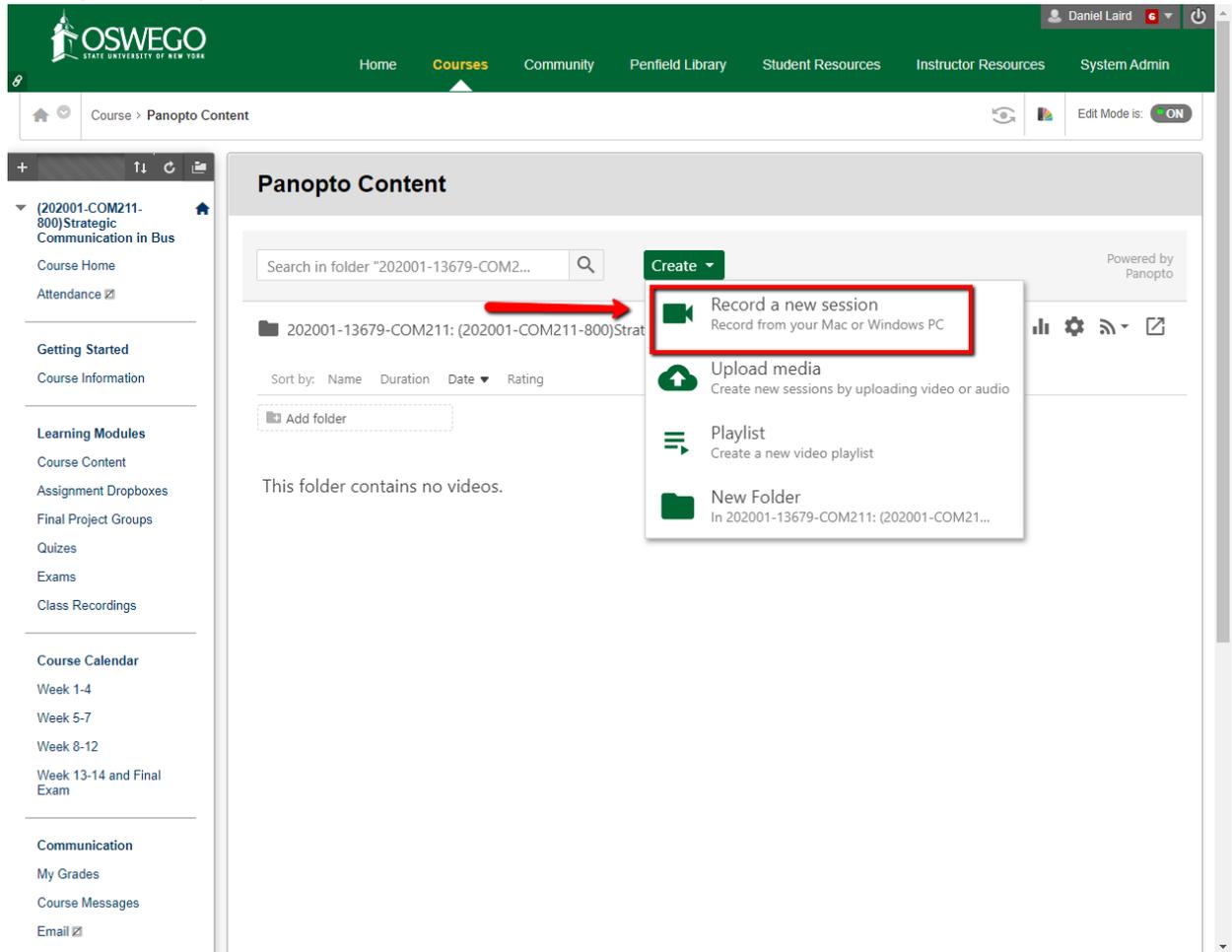


Downloading and Installing Panopto

Please note – if you have not already [setup Panopto in your Blackboard folder](#), you must do that before you can proceed to downloading and installing the Panopto recorder on your computer.

1. Go to your Panopto folder in Blackboard and click on the Create button.
