## Summer and Fall '21 Registration Information

Summer '21 registration is currently open

Fall '21 registration begins April 5

- Check “myOswego” to find out the exact date and time you are eligible to register. Course offerings can be found online at “myOswego.”
- Students should make an appointment to meet with their advisor each semester before registering.

Eligibility dates are determined by the number of credit hours earned, and can be found on your myOswego in the “Registration” tab under “Check Your Registration Status”

The C&I Advisement Center has their appointment times listed online, available through youcanbook.me. Stop by or go online to sign up for an appointment. Be sure to sign up early!

## Class Scheduler to be Removed from MyOswego!

The Registrar will be removing the Class Scheduler link from the Registration tab of myOswego and updating our website accordingly.

"Registration and Planning (Plan Ahead, Register for Classes)" in myOswego remains the primary and most robust toolset for registration, with basic add/drop functionality also available in the SUNY Oswego Mobile app.

## Student Teaching Advisement Reminder:

All cognate courses must be completed **with a grade of C-** or higher prior to student teaching. Cognate courses include:

**Childhood:** PSY 100, HDV 322, Foreign Language, Gen Ed Computer Literacy course or competency exam, MAT 106, MAT 206, Natural Science with a lab, SSHS 1020, DASA 1020.

**Adolescence:** PSY 100, HDV 323, Foreign Language, Gen Ed Computer Literacy course or competency exam, SSHS 1020, DASA 1020.

**TESOL:** PSY 100, HDV 322 or HDV 323, or PSY 320; Foreign Language, Gen Ed Computer Literacy course or competency exam, SSHS 1020, DASA 1020.

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## Graduating August or December 2021? Complete a Senior Checklist Today!

Seniors need to file for graduation online by doing the following:

1. Log in to “myOswego”
2. Click on the “Student Records” tab
3. Click on “Apply for Graduation” and complete the required information
4. In your Degree Works audit, view the new “Senior Check form” requirement now listed for each major/minor.
5. Click on the link and print the form.
6. \*Meet with Ms. Kyle or Ms. Smith through youcanbookme to review and sign your checklist form you printed.

#### August 2021 Graduation:

Dates to apply online: April 1, 2020 to Feb 2, 2021

Deadline to return Senior Check Forms: April 1, 2021

#### December 2021 Graduation:

Dates to apply online: January 1, 2021 to April 1, 2021

Deadline to return Senior Check Forms: May 1, 2021

**Please note:** Students must file by the deadline dates for their names to be printed in the commencement program. Be sure to declare all majors and minors prior to applying for graduation and confirm that they are listed on page one of your online application in myOswego.

**All students must sign their senior checklist to be eligible to graduate.**

**August graduates participate in the May graduation ceremony; no special permission needed.**
