

Alumni Survey - Employment and Certification

The SUNY Oswego School of Education Alumni Survey is an instrument used to measure the program completer satisfaction with their preparation and is used to collect self-reported information regarding the completer's certification and employment. Annually, completers from one, three, and five years post-graduation are invited to participate in the survey. Below are the results from the response to three survey questions about employment and certification. The 2019 iteration includes completers who graduated in 2014, 2016, and 2018; the 2020 iteration includes completers who graduated in 2015, 2017, and 2019; the 2021 iteration includes completers who graduated in 2016, 2018, and 2020; and the 2022 iteration includes completers who graduated in 2011.
