



Completer Certification Rates

Completer certification rates were compiled by comparing two reports: 1) individuals prepared by SUNY Oswego and New York State certifications issued, obtained from New York State Teach System; and 2) annual graduation reports obtained by the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment. Table A includes data for undergraduate and graduate completers who have obtained certification in the area in which they were prepared. Data in Tables B and C contains completers for the initial and advanced programs and their status in obtaining certification in their area of preparation. For those seeking professional certification, additional requirements beyond program completion may include a specific time as a classroom teacher. Therefore, we will update these data annually and anticipate that the percentages will increase over time. All data account for completers only certified in New York State. Completers certified in other states are not included as certified in these data.
