

Edward Austin Sheldon (October 4, 1823 – August 26, 1897)

A leader in education and an advocate of free public schools, Edward Austin Sheldon (1823-1897) was responsible for opening the Oswego Normal School in May 1861 — which became what we now know as SUNY Oswego. Sheldon's pioneering ideas in object teaching became a model for other normal schools throughout the nation and around the world.
