* DESTINATION OSWEGO SCHOLARSHIP

Worth \$6,000 - \$9,000 per year, renewable for 4 years. Awarded to all undergraduate international students upon acceptance to the university.

* MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to first-year undergraduate students with at least a B+ high school average and a score of at least 1120 on the SAT. Merit scholarships range from \$750 - \$5,000 per year for up to 4 years.

* CO-OP SCHOLARSHIPS

\$6,000, renewable merit Co-op Scholarships (up to \$24,000 for four years) awarded to Freshman entering SUNY Oswego in the fall term. If awarded a Co-op Scholarship, this award will replace your Presidential Scholarship.
