International Student Fact Sheet 2015-2016

At a Glance:

- SUNY Oswego currently hosts **211** international & exchange students from **27** different countries.
- 103 undergraduates; 4 graduate; 104 non-degree (exchange & international from Brazil).
- International students comprise **2.7%** of the total student body and **1.1%** of the first year class.
- Top five countries of origin: South Korea (25.6%), China (20.9%), Brazil (12.8%), Canada (9.5%), and Spain (4.7%).
- Top majors of study: Business, Management, Marketing and Related Support Services (26.5%); Biological and Biomedical Sciences (3.8%); Computer and Information Sciences and Support Services (3.8%).
- Among degree-seeking students **17.8%** are studying in a STEM field.
