	Scholarship Letters(s)
	Assistantships or other letters issued by the school
	Confirmation page of DS-160 Nonimmigrant Visa Application form
	Payment receipt for the Form DS-160 Nonimmigrant Visa Application fee
	Photo <i>Bring one printed photo in case your photo upload fails; photo requirements are listed online at travel.state.gov</i>
	SEVIS Fee Receipt <i>I-901 Payment Confirmation printed from the fmjfee.com website</i>
