How much does it cost to print something at Penfield Library?



It depends on the size and weight. This <u>chair</u> prints in four pieces and weighs 5-6 grams (depending on the color).



This piece of <u>chain mail</u> is much bigger. It also needs a raft (printed base) to hold up the rings as it prints. The raft is weighed with the object and counts toward the price.



This is from a scan of an actual <u>platypus</u> <u>skull</u>. Because it's an odd shape, it needed printed supports to print correctly. The supports are weighed with the object and count towards the price. They are easy to remove, but we find that needle-nose pliers are helpful.
