News & Happenings

- Penfield librarians and staff have answered 3,448 questions from students, faculty, staff, and alumni since the beginning of the fall semester. The majority of these were asked at the Circulation Desk and the Research Help Desk, with the rest asked/answered at Special Collections, Research Parties, Welcome Tables, and the AskUs24/7 Chat Reference services co-op.
- Penfield Librarians have also provided information literacy instruction in 60+ classes across the curriculum this semester, with more scheduled during the remaining weeks of the semester.
- o Archives & Special Collections has been hard at work on the Millard Fillmore Papers, adding metadata and creating a searchable Guide for researchers.
- The library's **Employee Directory Page** has been redesigned. It's now easier than ever to reach out to us. Take a look and get in touch!
- The Library Diversity Committee is working on a variety of ideas and projects aimed at making the library more inclusive and accessible for all members of the SUNY Oswego community. These include improvements in programming, partnerships, spaces, and collections. Look for more info in the coming months.
- o The Student Library Ambassadors are creating social media posts, planning Instagram takeovers, and sharing in event planning for the fall and spring semesters.
- Penfield Library hosted a Library Instruction Session for **Transfer Students** on October 28th. It was an opportunity for transfer students to catch up on library services.

- Our Resource Sharing librarian and staff have been working on a pilot project with California State University libraries on ALMA, a cloud-based library services platform. Projects like this are the reason that Penfield Library's ILL services continue to be top notch.
- o Penfield Librarians and staff participated in fire extinguisher training at the end of October. It was informative (and a little fun!), and we're all better prepared to deal with a fire emergency.
- The library put together a **Mental Health Support basket** for the SEFA Baskets of Caring fund raiser. It's loaded with good stuff to help support well-being during the dark days of winter in Oswego.
