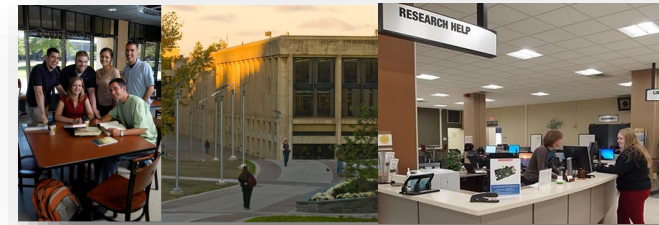
Penfield Library History

Penfield Library opened in its current location in 1968. The library is named for Lida S. Penfield (1873-1956). Lida chaired the English Department and was an authority on local history. She wrote *Stories of Old Oswego*, and helped inaugurate the college's Torchlight Ceremony in 1936.
