


What students need to know:

Important info about sexual and interpersonal violence

- **Victims/survivors can choose to report, they are not required**
- **Even if they report, they do not have to file charges**
- **We still want everyone to report so we can help**
- **Most employees (including student employees) are mandated reporters and cannot promise confidentiality**
- **Students can confidentially report to Counseling or Walker Health Center staff**
- **Students can also confidentially report to Services to Aid Families (SAF) if something happens to them.**
