- Innovation & Design Process
 - Knowledgeable, experienced project team
 - Design charette (intensive, hands-on workshop) involving many constituents held
- Location & Linkages
 - Access to open space – the Great Lawn encourages community, socialization, exercise & well-being
 - Near community resources
 - Walk & bike paths
 - Campus activities/amenities
 - Campus shuttle & city bus routes
- Sustainable Site
 - Erosion control (during construction and permanent)
 - Drought-resistant plantings
 - Nontoxic pest control
- Water Efficiency
 - Perimeter drainage
 - High-Efficiency Irrigation system
 - High-Efficiency and Very High-Efficiency fixtures



LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) categories:

- Energy & Atmosphere
 - Energy Star-Rated appliances
 - Compact Fluorescent bulbs (CFLs) throughout complex
- Materials & Resources
 - Structurally Insulated Panels (SIPs) used for all exteriors
 - Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)-Certified tropical wood used
 - All flooring made with 45% recycled content
 - Low VOC (Volatile Organic Compound) materials
- Indoor Environmental Quality
 - Indoor Environmental Quality Energy Recovery Unit (ERU)
 - Indoor Contaminant Control – mudroom specifically designed with porcelain tiles and walk-off mats to remove dirt and debris from shoes before entering unit
- Awareness & Education
 - Required resident orientation and training sessions
 - Open Houses to inform and educate members of the College and local community

THE COMPLEX

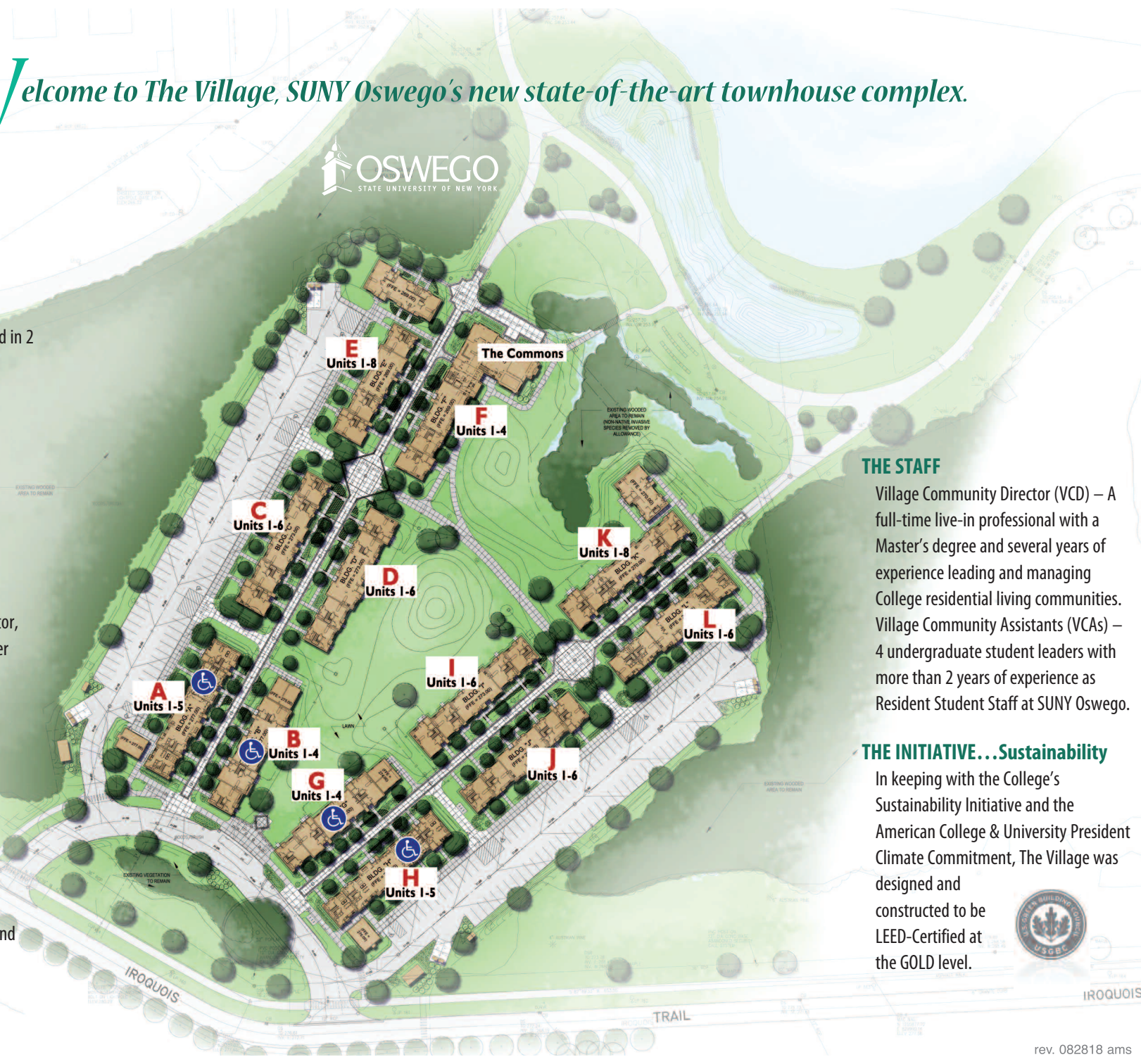
- 68 units
