Thank you for your interest in STARTALK: Chinese Language and Culture Summer Camp. Participants will learn communication skills through an interactive approach to language learning. The summer camp starts on July 2 and ends on July 21. Instruction runs from Monday to Friday; classes begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m. The closing ceremony is on Saturday, July 21 at 10 a.m.

We welcome Grades 3-12 students with or without a Chinese Language background. With the support of a federal grant, **there is no program fee**. Sixty applicants will be invited to the program and placed in four classes based on their grades and levels of proficiency in Mandarin Chinese. Full participation in the three-week program is required. No partial attendance is accepted.

Please submit your application package as soon as you can.

The application package includes three parts: (A) Application Form, (B) Two Letters of Recommendation, and (C) Report Card. All applicants need to complete the Application Form, including a statement of interest (200-250 words) explaining why they would like to participate in the camp. They also need to contact teachers who have taught them and who are willing to provide a Letter of Recommendation. Their current Report Card should be submitted as well.
